



Hearts for Homes (H4H) is a non-profit charitable organization whose goal is to end child homelessness in Macomb County, Michigan by helping homeless children and their families secure a stable home. H4H also provides connections to services and resources that empower families to break the cycle of poverty and inspire hope of achieving greater economic stability.



THERE IS AN AFFORDABLE HOUSING CRISIS

Approximately 3,000 homeless children are without a stable permanent home. In addition, over 21,000 very-low and extremely low-income households are paying more than half their income in housing expenses. This puts many of these households at higher risk for homeless episodes. Children and families are often bounced from relatives, to hotels, to 'couch-surfing' with friends, and are in need of stable homes <u>now!</u>

The H4H Affordable Housing Partnership (AHP) Program assists families of homeless children obtain rental housing in Macomb County, MI.

The H4H AHP Program helps reduce the risk of private landlords by providing:

- Limited short-term motel payment assistance for families approved for rental by landlord until unit is ready for move-in.
- Partial security deposit and rent payments, or other assistance, to help families get established in their new home.

• Volunteers help connect families to services and resources empowering families to break the cycle of poverty and achieve economic stability.
